- 1. Check-ins: Most embarrassing moment
- 2. Devotions & Opening Prayer Justin
- 3. Previous Minutes (Motion to approve) Tina made a motion to approve the minutes.

Ryan 2nd Motion carried

- 1. May 2nd Congregation Meeting- Assoc Pastor Call Vote
- 4. Treasurer's Report (Motion to accept) Motion to accept: Jamie, Darrin 2nd
- a. April was a strong month. First month that we had more income than expenses.
- b. Summer months have been down 13% than the first months of the year.
- c. New Pastor will increase expenses monthly by about \$7200.
- d. Jason suggested Stewardship team make a push for the automatic giving (Mogive).
- e. Jamie volunteered to follow through with this suggestion.
- 5. Pastor's report:
- a. Mark's position has changed to part time and he has signed paperwork.
- b. Posting for Traditional Music coordinator is going out tomorrow and Pastor already has an interest.
- c. Custodian position still open.
- d. Pastor Bailey Fossum has officially accepted our call. The paperwork has been submitted. June 10th is her final day at her current church. She is encouraged to take 2 weeks off. We are looking at her starting by the end of June. We would encourage her to attend the Houston trip and Crow Wing Canoe trip with the youth.
- e. Administrative: Keeping the meals on Wednesday nights by having food trucks here.
- f. Three of four companies have given bids on the sound system. There will be a decision coming on this soon. We do have a new drum set.

- g. Outdoor worship is Aug. 19th.
- 6. Old Business
 - 1. Synod Assembly participants (May 31-June 2)
- a. No one from council is able to commit to attend
- b. Jamie made a motion not to send anyone to Synod Assembly. Darrin 2nd. passed
 - 2. Parking lot Light update-Ryan
- a. There is a wiring issue that is tripping the breakers. We will need to replace that wiring and replace bulbs.
- b. Dave Patzlaff has taken the reins on this. He can get the lift and will donate time and materials etc..
- c. Ryan is suggesting we update the 7 fixtures to LED bulbs at approx \$175 a piece. A member has volunteered to pay for half the cost of the bulbs. The old bulbs cost \$75 a piece but do not last as long as the LED.
- d. Pastor states that these could fall under Maintenance of \$7500 in the budget.
- e. Emergency Exit lighting: 4 or 5 of them need repair at \$90 a piece(per ballast). An alternative to this is 'exposed lighting packs" to use at only \$20 a piece. Dave Patzlaff will install. These meet code and have a battery pack in them.
- f. The consensus of council was to proceed with this as routine maintenance.
 - 3. Strategic Planning: Council determines priorities moving forward and then letting the teams and congregation.
 - a. When can we do this? We are having a difficult time to get everyone together for this.
 - b. Jason suggested we trim the roster and get those who are passionate about this since we cannot get all 9 of us together. He suggested having a plan to launch by Rally Sunday in the fall.
 - c. Tina will put options via email to all of us to choose.

- 4. Vote Via email on the Security-Ryan
- a. This has been approved previously with addition to \$12.50 maintenance per month that was approved via email previously.
- b. Ryan will proceed with this.
- 7. New Business
 - 1. Stewardship Team Special Appeal (Pave the Way/ \$56,000 balance) Jamie
- a. Create a display of the parking lot and have envelopes to choose from the display. Put the envelopes in the pews, too.
- b. Purchase kiddy cars that Jamie would donate and then have a raffle.
- c. Match box cars to choose to make a donation.
- d. Have a celebration event
- e. Projected cost \$650
- f. Conversation would be to give "Above and beyond your traditional gifts".
- g. There would be a narrow time period for this special appeal.
 - 2. Communication meeting-1 and 2 to come May 30th.
- a. The first meeting was about where we currently are with this communication issue.
- A strategic meeting as to how to communicate with each other and with the congregation will be the 2nd meeting.
- c. Jason is suggesting the leading team get together before the May 30th meeting to develop a plan.
- d. A prior planning meeting will be decided on and let council know.
 - 3. Property Items:
- a. Fundraiser for Kitchen upgrades: Ryan
- A. Jackie Cerkowniak is asking for a fundraiser to get a better source for hot water. It would be under a Thrivent Action grant. There would be a raffle for Menards gift cards to raise funds, also.

- Jamie suggested a financial proposal. Donna would like Jackie to bring back other
 options for fundraisers other than a raffle. Ryan will go back to Jackie with suggestions.
 Fundraiser died for failure to motion.
- B. Mowing Team: Fuel, Mower and Trimmer request.
 - 1. The team is requesting that we pay for the fuel for the mowers. \$250 is already budgeted. Once that is used council will have to determine how to proceed.
 - Pastor suggested that Kris be responsible for keeping the gas cans full each week. He will let Kris know.
 - 3. Bud Lewison would like the option to purchase a used lawn mower. We don't feel we have the funds for a mower at this time. We will budget for next year.
 - 4. There is \$140 dedicated funds to be able to purchase a trimmer.
